**'SHEEP2012'** is a major sheep event being held at Teagasc, Mellows Campus, Athenry, Co Galway on Saturday, 30th June 2012, 10.00am. With a positive outlook for sheep, it is appropriate that all parties interested in a viable sheep industry come together with the common aim of capitalising on the potential that sheep production offers. While this event is of major interest to all involved in the sheep industry it will also appeal to those with an interest in rural affairs.

**'SHEEP2012'** is the major sheep event in the agricultural calendar for the year and is an event that everyone with a commercial interest in sheep will want to attend.

**'SHEEP2012'** will be formally opened by An Taoiseach, Mr. Enda Kenny, T.D.

There will be a comprehensive programme, in booklet form, covering all activities and this will be distributed free of charge to patrons attending.

Non-show Breed Society (including 2 entrance tickets)	€100
