

## Derrypatrick Farm Notes Week beginning 16/11/2015

### General Details

- 99% of Early maturing cattle slaughtered and 55% of Late maturing cattle slaughtered
- Male Calves gaining 1.26kg/day since birth (Average weight: 307kg on 27/09/2015)
- Female Calves gaining 1.12kg/day since birth (Average weight: 279kg on 27/09/2015)
- Average cow weight on 26<sup>th</sup> August was 735kg
- All weaning completed on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October

### Grassland Details

- All animals housed on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> November due to ground conditions
- Average farm cover 650 kg DM/Ha
- Target was 66% closed by 1<sup>st</sup> November and 100% closed by 1<sup>st</sup> December
- Soil samples will be taken at the end of December

### Housing Details

- Finishing heifers housed on straw and getting 6kg concentrates and ad-lib first cut 78DMD silage
- Finishing steers housed on slats and getting 7kg concentrates and ad-lib first cut silage
- Male weanlings housed on slats and getting 2kg concentrates and ad-lib first cut silage
- Female weanlings housed on slats and getting 1.5kg concentrates and ad-lib first cut silage
- Cows housed on slats and receiving ad-lib first cut silage for first 2-3 weeks and will be changed to lessor quality second cut silage depending on condition score
- Remaining cull cows receiving 7kg concentrates and ad-lib first cut silage

### Key recommendations

- Monitor weanlings closely for any signs of pneumonia in sheds
- Finishing cattle to be clipped this week (backs and tails)
- Meeting about water supply to paddocks and upgrading required
- Order fluke, worm and lice treatments for all cattle indoors
- Weigh finishing cattle next week
