



Information on College Courses Leading to Level 5 Certificates

2017/2018 ACADEMIC YEAR

LEVEL 5 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be 17 years on 1 January 2018 or have completed the Leaving Certificate or equivalent. While there is no minimum education entry requirement those who have completed the Leaving Certificate are likely to benefit most. For some Level 5 courses, students will be required to undertake an entrance exam.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications should be made directly to the college of your choice using the appropriate application form.

LEVEL 6 COURSES

On completion of Level 5 courses students will normally proceed to an appropriate Level 6 course.

TEAGASC STUDENT MAINTENANCE GRANT SCHEME

The Teagasc Student Maintenance Grant Scheme is available for students attending Further Level Courses at Teagasc and Private Agricultural College for the 2017/2018 academic year.

Means testing will apply to Level 5 and Level 6 courses in 2017/2018.

Teagasc student maintenance grants are paid through Teagasc and the grant scheme is managed by Teagasc. **Please do not apply to SUSI for the Teagasc Student Maintenance Grant Scheme.**

FEES

These include an application fee, registration fee, a deposit and additional course charges. Fees will vary in accordance with course type and duration. Additional charges for residential accommodation and food to be applied by colleges where appropriate.
