Farm Safety Code of Practice training courses will take place at a centre near you from October 2017 onwards.

It is a legal requirement to complete and update the Farm Safety Code of Practice or to prepare a safety statement.

New code

A revised code with a green cover came into operation on July 1, 2017. The old version is being phased out over a period of 18 months from that date. This means that all persons will have to complete the revised version by December 31, 2018.
