

Contract Silage Production Agreement

Definitions

- Land owner or person occupying land on lease who is prepared to make land available for silage/fodder production is defined as the seller.
- Person for whom silage is grown on contract is defined as the purchaser.

Contract

I (seller) _____, agree to grow a crop of grass silage and/ or forage crop for (purchaser) _____ commencing on August ____ and finishing on the agreed date of _____, 2018.

The Seller shall: keep the contract area free from livestock for the period of the contract; not remove or allow any others to remove any grass/ forage from these contracted fields; roll this land at the beginning of the contract.

The Purchaser shall: apply fertiliser and seed on the contract area; remove the crop for silage/ zero graze before the agreed date; and cover related costs.

It is agreed that the purchaser will pay the seller €____/acre for the contracted land or a total of €_____ on the commencement date of this contract.

Each party agrees they have clarified their fertilizer limits situation with regard to the Nitrates Directive (SI 605, 2017) before signing this contract.
