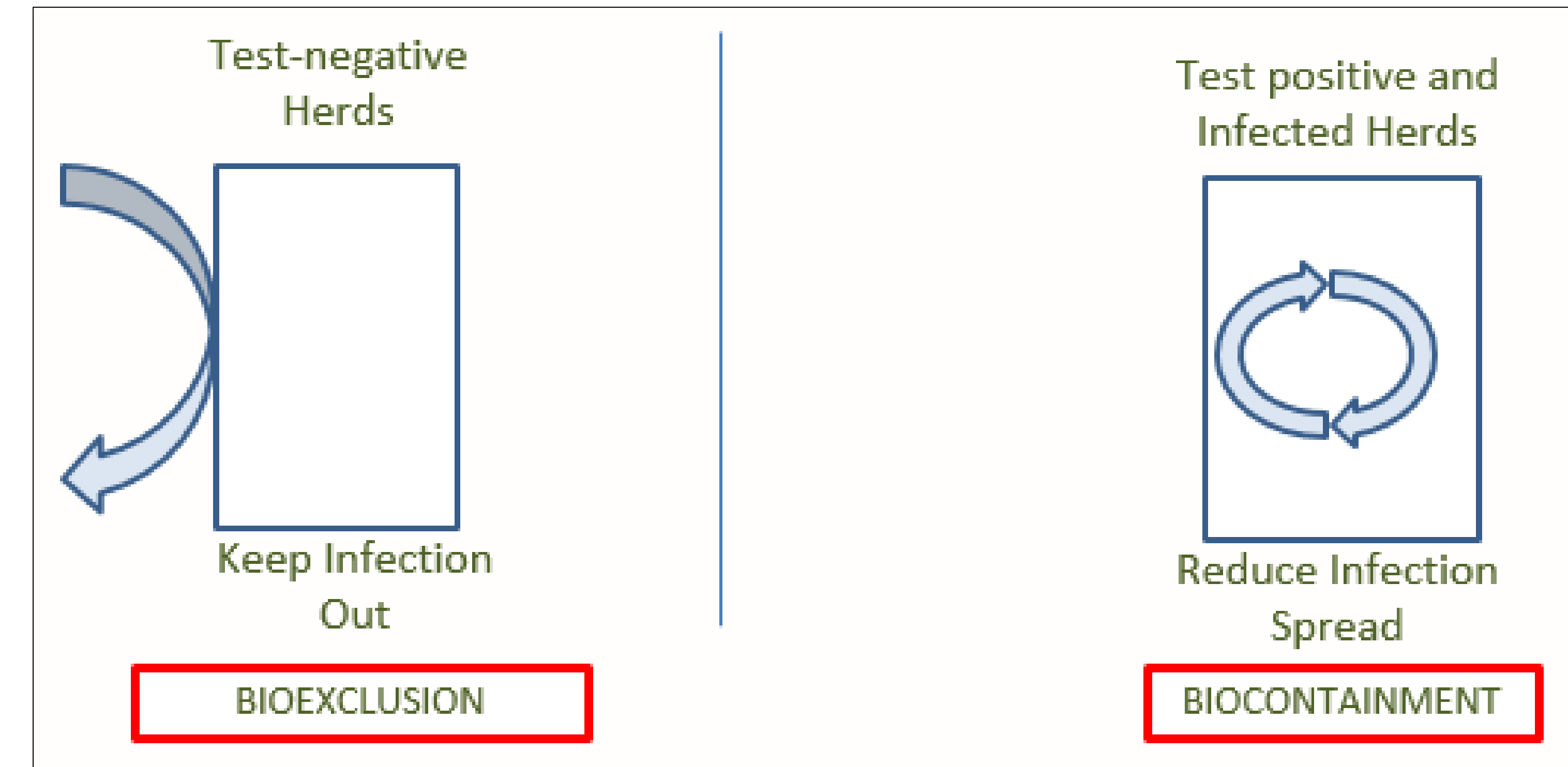
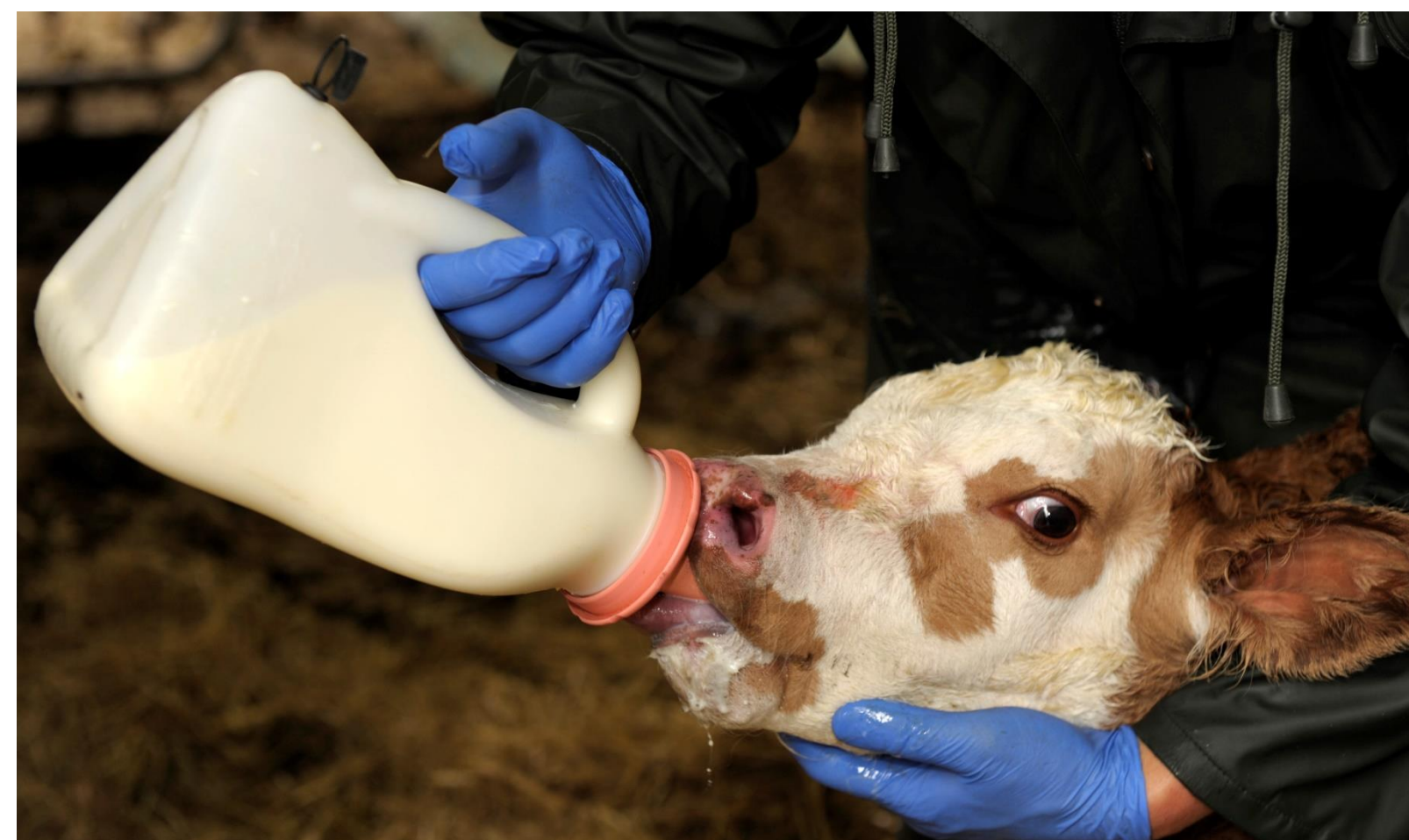


**Effective biosecurity** for Johne's includes all the practices which **prevent infection entering** a herd (**bioexclusion**) and **limit its spread** (**biocontainment**) if it is introduced.

## Johne's **prevention** and **control** methods:

- Limit stock introductions
- Hygiene at calf feeding, clean protective clothing in the calf house
- Both elements are important in **all** herds



## Action points

- **Remove infected** and ELISA **test-positive** animals
- **Select** introductions from **high assurance** herds or keep or maintain a closed herd.
- **Feed clean colostrum** and **milk** from **test-negative** cows to calves
